2. Each year the annual accounts are audited by the Auditor General for Wales. Prior to this date, any interested person has the opportunity to inspect and make copies of the accounts and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts etc relating to them for 20 working days on reasonable notice. 3. From 11 September 2023, until the audit has been completed, Local Government Electors and their representatives also have:
 - the right to question the Auditor General about the accounts.
 - the right to attend before the Auditor General and make objections to the accounts or any item in them. Written notice of an objection must first be given to the Auditor General. A copy of the written notice must also be given to the council.

Electors' rights

The basic position

By law, any interested person (including a representative) also has the right to inspect and challenge an item of

The right to inspect the accounts

When a local government publishes its annual accounts for a year, it must advertise them and give you reasonable notice of your right to inspect the accounts and support the accounts and most of the time you will have to pay a copying charge.

The right to ask the Auditor General

You can only ask the Auditor General if you think the Auditor General does not have to do something or if the accounts or anything else in them is wrong. You must tell the Auditor General whether he thinks something is wrong and if it is lawful or reasonable.

The right to object to the accounts

If you think that the body has caused a loss to someone or if you think someone has caused a loss to someone you can object to the Auditor General. You **must be in writing** to the Auditor General and you must apply to the courts for a decision on your objection. If you are not satisfied with a decision on your objection, you must also apply to the courts. You must also send a copy of your objection to the Auditor General.

You may also object if you think the Auditor General should discuss an 'interest report'. Again, you must be in writing to the Auditor General at the address below. In this case, you must also send a copy of your objection to the Auditor General.
